Step 1

There are some requirements that are outlined in the application form, such as providing us with Police clearance before you start with us.

Step 3

Before you commence with us, we require you to undertake our **Volunteer Training** on a Saturday afternoon, and our Induction on a separate Tuesday evening. Upon completion of the Volunteer training, you will receive a Certificate of Achievement.

Step 4

Once you have completed the Volunteer Training afternoon we will then schedule you in for an **interview with our Volunteer & Internship Coordinator** to work together to find the right volunteer position for you.

Step 5

Our Volunteer vacancies are many and varied. **Placement** in any of the positions will be largely determined by your skills, personality and experience. We look forward to welcoming you to the team!
