



Five Focus Areas

The Institute works to build community commitment and capacity to act and reflect in the service of social justice. Activities include immersions, community education, professional development, research and advocacy. We survive through registration fees for our education and training programs, and donations, grants and bequests from individuals and organisations.

The Institute's Board has identified five major Focus Areas, each with an accompanying Objective:

Focus Area 1: Transformative social justice education and service learning

Objective: To be recognised as a centre of excellence in transformative social justice education and service learning.

Focus Area 2: Engaging with and building a community for social justice

Objective: To enhance and build sustainable relationships so that a community for social justice grows and develops.

Focus Area 3: Fostering research in areas of social justice

Objective: To be recognised for excellence in social justice research.

Focus Area 4: Supporting advocacy and action

Objective: To advocate for and act in the interests of social justice, particularly the poor and marginalised.

Focus Area 5: Sustainability

Objective: To ensure that the Centre and its programs are sustainable.
